The report recommends appointing Network Training Ltd to provide and maintain a website. Cllr Kerr and Cllr Futrell have looked at the work this company does and they believe it will work very well, They have done websites for many parish councils. Money of £590 has been received from the Government Transparency Code fund. The cost will be £549 in this year and then £180 a year. (See report for figures) This is the last year we can get the grant and will have to give it back if not used. The report Identified areas that may flood and potential measures to protect properties, i.e. Property Level Resilience (e.g. flood boards, raising a threshold) and Natural Flood Management (e.g. try and hold the water up with more grass in rivers and streams and keep the Brook clear through Burton).
