TUESDAY 6TH AUGUST – Start: 10:00 am **Colerne Tuesday Tramp**

Difficulty: **MODERATE** Duration: **3 HOURS** Distance: **5 MILES** Start point: **FOX AND HOUNDS CAR PARK, COLERNE HIGH SREET SN14 8DB OS REF. ST 818 711 ///CABINETS.ROOMS. PROPOSALS.** A walk around the various footpaths of Colerne. Bring a mid-morning munchie. Park at pub or adjacent Constitutional Club.

SATURDAY 10TH AUGUST – Start: 10:00 am **Two Ways and a Monument**

Difficulty: **STRENUOUS** Duration: **5 HOURS** Distance: **10 MILES** Start point: **COLD ASHTON PARISH HALL OS REF. ST 748 726 ///BLOWN.GOING.STRETCH.** A walk along the Cotswold Way, descending to Doynnton to follow the Monarch's Way to Wick then a climb to the Cotswold Way which we follow back to the start. Please bring a packed lunch.

MONDAY 12TH AUGUST – Start: 10:00 am **From Egypt through Rome to Windsor**

Difficulty: **MODERATE** Duration: **3 HOURS** Distance: **5.5 MILES** Start point: **EGYPT MILLS CAR PARK, NAILSWORTH, GL6 0AE OS REF. ST 849 999 ///BURGLARS.EMBER.HAGGLING.** We follow the old railway line from Nailsworth to North Woodchester. Turning uphill we visit the site of a Roman Villa and return via South Woodchester and Windsoradge. Most of the walk is along quiet lanes. There are three off-road sections which are relatively steep and can be muddy. Egypt Mill at the start and end of the walk has a fine café-bar.

SATURDAY 17TH AUGUST – Start: 10:00 am **Marshfield – Town and Valleys**

Difficulty: **MODERATE** Duration: **2.5 HOURS** Distance: **4.5 MILES** Start point: **MARET PLACE, MARSHFIELD OS REF. ST 781 737.** A morning walk, starting in the centre of this small medieval market town, taking paths SW through fields to the St Catherine valley and returning to the Almshouses and along the High Street. Lunch choice of 2 pubs and a teashop – and stay to enjoy Marshfield Village Day on the Withymead from 13:30. Suitable for families.
